FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

I am pleased to put new edition of our college Newsletter Koh I Maran Post 2021 before you. After respite from the Covid-19 Pandemic, start of on-campus academics was a major challenge. The fact, that students had been used to online teaching, stay-home attitude and threat of infection was holding them back. The College reached out to the students through 'Covid Warrior Program' and was able to conduct a mega pre-admission counselling for admission 2021. During the year, the college addressed the major challenge of Examinations by conducting on-line proctored examinations for various semesters. With active cooperation of the students and the faculty alike, the alternative way of conducting the examinations proved fruitful in continuation of academic journey of students.

A major boost to college infrastructure came in the form of Government sanction for Administrative block with state of the art 400 seater Auditorium at a cost of 780.91 Lacs and a G+3 Building for housing Admission, Examination, IT&SS and Research Hub at a cost of 484.77 Lacs.


Visit To The **College Of Temperate Sericulture Research Institute**- Mirgund Baramulla






The College has a separate dispensary block, where first aid medical facilities are provided to the students and the faculty. Medicines & other first aid facilities are provide to the students, free of cost.


INTERNET






