

INTRODUCTION



MISSION



The Year 2022 is historic for Higher Education in UT of J&K for commencement of Implementation of Uniform Academic Calendar and National Education Policy being two big ticket measures of Higher Education Department to bring effective change in student favour. Uniform academic calendar will put our students at par with National Calendar and will remove the inherent shortcomings of extension in program duration, asymmetrical time lines and postponements of examinations on one or the other pretext.



ABOUT NEP 2020

NEP 2020 aims to make education options flexible for the student to help them decide the best course of action for their future by exploring multiple options.



Student gets to choose different courses as Major, Minor and Multidisciplinary, The student can then later finalise a field of study.



Multiple Options

Students choose more than one subject to learn.



Specialise

Students can choose to specialise later in their degree



Multiple Exits

Students can exit at 1st, 2nd or 3rd year and receive Certificate, Diploma and Degree respectively.



Honours & Research

Students completing 4 years receive Honours or Honours with Research Degree



Skill Development

Students get to learn Skill Courses and Internship opportunities to help them achieve employability and promote entrepreneurship.



Academic Bank of Credits

Students get their credits earned in the ABC that enables easy transfer of credits earned and online learning.

WHY IS IT BENEFICIAL?

NEP gives students flexibility and allows them to pursue a multidisciplinary and holistic education along with learning Employability Skills.

4 MAJOR/MINOR CREDIT

Students choose a Major and Minor course of study for the first three semesters. Students will get an opportunity to change their Major subject at the end of the third semester. The college offered all subjects as Major and Minor. The student can pursue 3+1 or 4+1 in the Major field of study.



3 MULTIDISCIPLINARY CREDIT

Students take one multidisciplinary course that is different from the courses of Major/Minor/10+2 level. This course will be changed per semester for three semesters and students will also be given an opportunity to switch to it as their Major course after three semesters.



3 SKILL CREDIT

Students choose from a wide variety of Skill Courses, for which admission is done on the basis of merit. These are employability training courses.



2 VA/MIL/AEC CREDIT

As per NEP guidelines students have to choose one Value Added (Digital Technological Solutions, Health and Wellness, Disaster Management) and one Ability Enhancement Course (English/Communication) and One Language Course (Urdu/ Hind/Kashmiri).







Launch of LMS and hand-holding of colleges



It has been the first fully automated/computerized college library in J&K that uses modern and state of the art information technology gadgets in its operations and services. The library has been continuously updated in many respects ranging from books and online resources collection in the year 2021.

The library successfully conducted an oriented/induction program for new and prospective entrants wherein detailed information was provided on various services offered by the library. ABC ID creation of students was also facilitated.


